Upon completion of the program, participants will have obtained essential knowledge in key areas relevant to their work in the field of ABI.

**MODULE #1 Thursday February 16, 9:00-3:30 McMaster University, Michael G. DeGroot Centre for Learning & Discovery (MDCL) Room 3024**

**Brain Anatomy (Physiology) & Brain Anatomy (Applied)**

**Brain Anatomy:** Participants will develop an increased understanding of functional neuroanatomy and brain behavior relationships as well as an understanding of some of the physical issues commonly associated with acquired brain injury.

**MODULE #2 Thursday April 12 9:00-3:30, McMaster University, MDCL Room 3024 Standards of Practice & Substance Abuse**

**Standards of Practice:** Workshop participants will be introduced to standards of professionalism and client care in the field of rehabilitation therapy.

**Substance Abuse:** introduction to Addictions/Substance abuse – for ABI service providers

**MODULE #3 Thursday June 14, 9:00-3:30 McMaster University, HSC Room 2J13 Teaching Skills & Cognitive Level I**

**Teaching Skills:** This interactive workshop will provide participants with the opportunity to develop and enhance their understanding and capacity in the areas of rapport building and teaching skills as they relate to their work with the ABI population.

**Cognitive Level 1:** Participants will have the opportunity to engage in an Inter-active workshop, designed to explore the cognitive deficits following brain injury and the most effective approaches to assist clients in compensating for these impairments.

**MODULE #4 Thursday September 20, 9:00-3:30 McMaster University, HSC Room TBD**

**Behaviour & Ethics**

**Behaviour Level 1:** An Introduction to Behaviour Analysis. Participants will gain an enhanced understanding of behavioural sequelae following ABI.

**Code of Ethics:** Participants will gain an increased understanding of issues surrounding consent/capacity and code of ethics and how these issues relate to their everyday practice.

**MODULE #5 Thursday November 15, 9:00-3:30, McMaster University, HSC Room TBD Cognitive 2 & Behaviour 2**

**Cognitive Level 2:** This advanced workshop will focus on Rehabilitation Therapist’s role in assisting clients with cognitive deficits resulting from brain injuries. Case examples, generated by participants, will be utilized to develop a “tool box” of strategies for client and worker.

**Behaviour Level 2:** A deeper exploration of Behaviour Analysis. Participants will expand their knowledge of the concepts introduced in Behaviour Level 1.
