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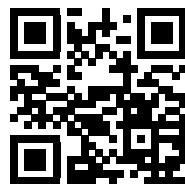

## OBJECTIVES

1. Review perioperative implications of Massive Transfusion and evidence based management.
2. Gain insight into fast tracking surgical repair of patients with hip fractures and resultant outcomes.
3. Debate need of Perioperative Clinics in identifying risks, reducing cancellations and improving outcomes.
4. Review the Anesthetic considerations of patients with Massive Trauma.
